

Transfer out from DWTC Authority to another Free Zone in Dubai



PLEASE SUBMIT

- 1. Online request through DWTCA portal
- **2.** A notarized attested board resolution, resolving to transfer the company out of DWTCA

Note: In case of a Corporate Shareholder, the board resolution must be provided by the parent company and must be attested by the UAE Embassy and Ministry of Foreign Affairs



ONCE RECEIVED AND REVIEWED, A NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) TO TRANSFER OUT WILL BE GRANTED AND YOU WILL NEED TO SUBMIT:

- **1.** An NOC Letter/Initial Approval Letter from the new Free Zone Authority (transferred to)
- 2. Proof that details regarding the transfer of the company have been published in both English (Gulf News or Khaleej Times) and Arabic (Al Bayan or Al Khaleej) for a minimum of 1 day
- **3.** Proof from company's external auditor that creditors have been notified about the transfer and have no objection
- **4.** Invoice for / transfer out will be shared with you payment to be completed
- **5.** Submit copy of license and establishment card issued by new Free Zone Authority

- **6.** Submit lease surrender/NOC from leasing department/landlord. This can be obtained from leasing department/ landlord. In case of a third party business centre, please provide an NOC from the business centre
- **7.** Please transfer all current visas under DWTCA to new Free Zone
- 8. Submit clearance from Etisalat. If this is not applicable please submit declaration letter on company letterhead that no account has been registered
- Submit clearance from DEWA. If this is not applicable please submit declaration letter on company letterhead that no account has been registered



"TRANSFER-OUT" LETTER WILL BE PROVIDED UPON COMPLETION OF ALL OF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS
